- ▶ Minakari is an art, as old as 1500 BC and first originated in Persia. A famous French explorer who visited Iran in Safavid time, has mentioned his observations about this admirable art. It's one of the most popular handicrafts of the country and you can find a large collection of the products in Naqshe Jahan square in Isfahan which is the center of this art in Iran.
- ▶ The pots are usually made of copper but in the past, Minakari was applied on gold and silver too
- ▶ They are designed with different colors. And then go into furnace, usually with 500°C temperature and the colors will be fixed on the pots.

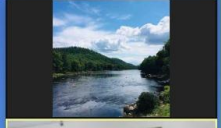

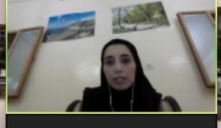
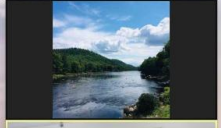

Naghsh-e Jahan Square

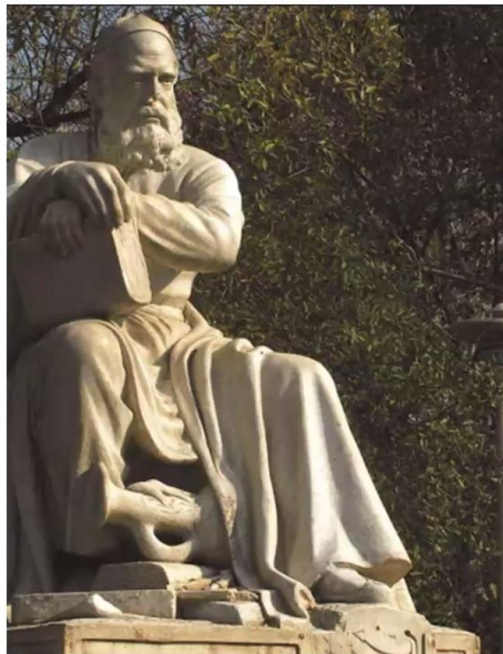
- ▶ Also known as Imam Square, is a square situated at the center of Isfahan in Iran.

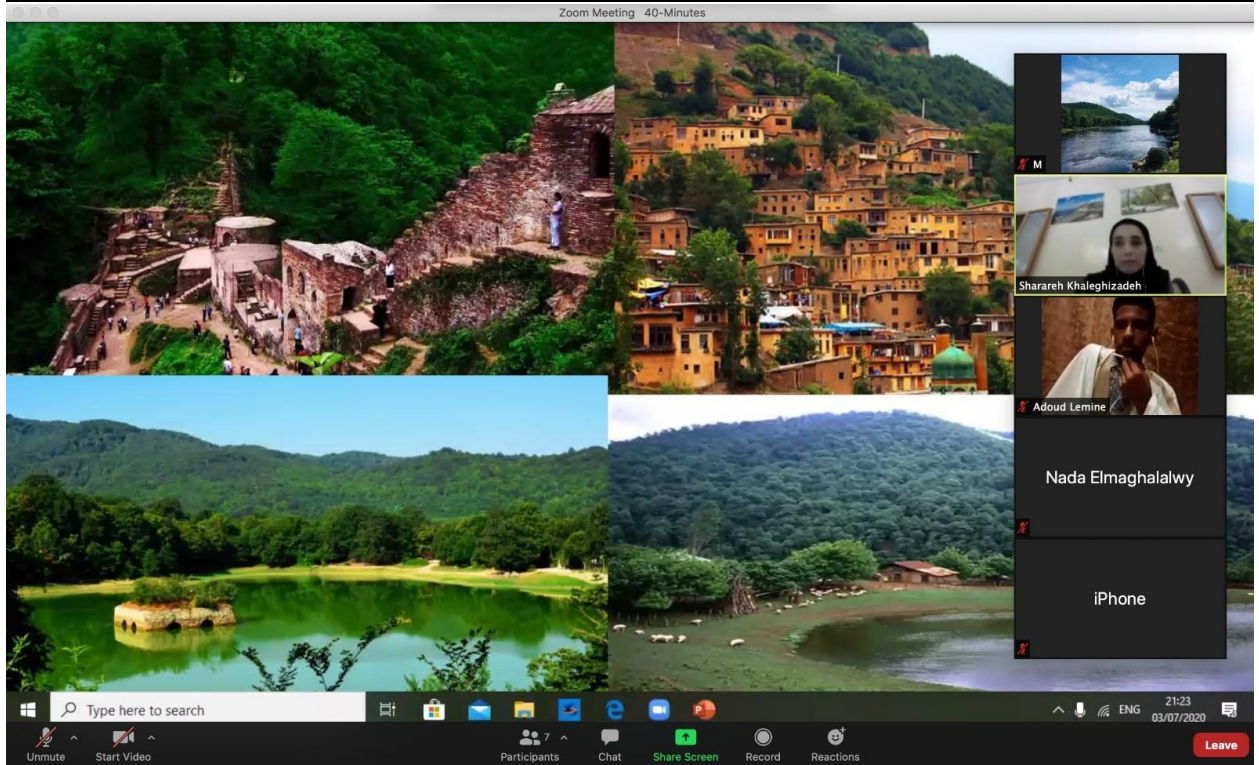
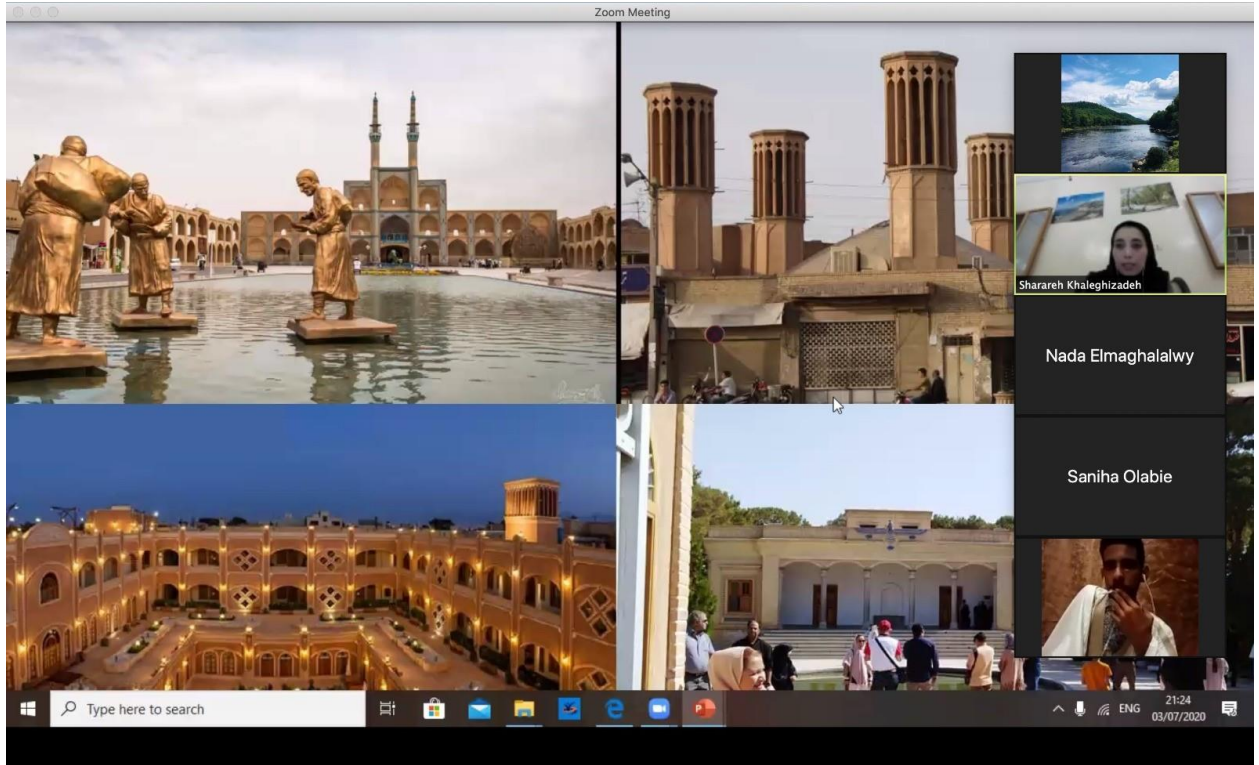

Omar Khayam Tomb

- ▶ Omar Khayyam was a Persian mathematician, astronomer, philosopher, and poet.
- ▶ He was born in Nishapur, in northeast of Iran and was buried there.
- ▶ As a mathematician, he is most notable for his work on the classification and solution of cubic equations. Khayyam also contributed to the understanding of the parallel axiom. As an astronomer, he designed the Jalali calendar, a solar calendar which is used in Iran. There is a tradition of attributing poetry to Omar Khayyam, written in the form of quatrains (*rubā'iyāt* رباعیات)
