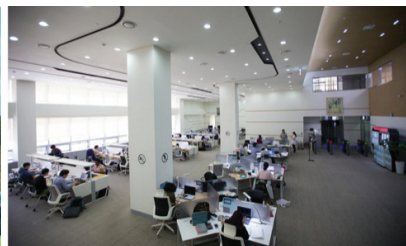


2019 NIIED GKS-KGSP Korean Government Scholarship Program



Why KDI School?

1. World-Class International Graduate School

 - ※ *KDI Central Library received the 1st prize in 2017 National Library Evaluation.*

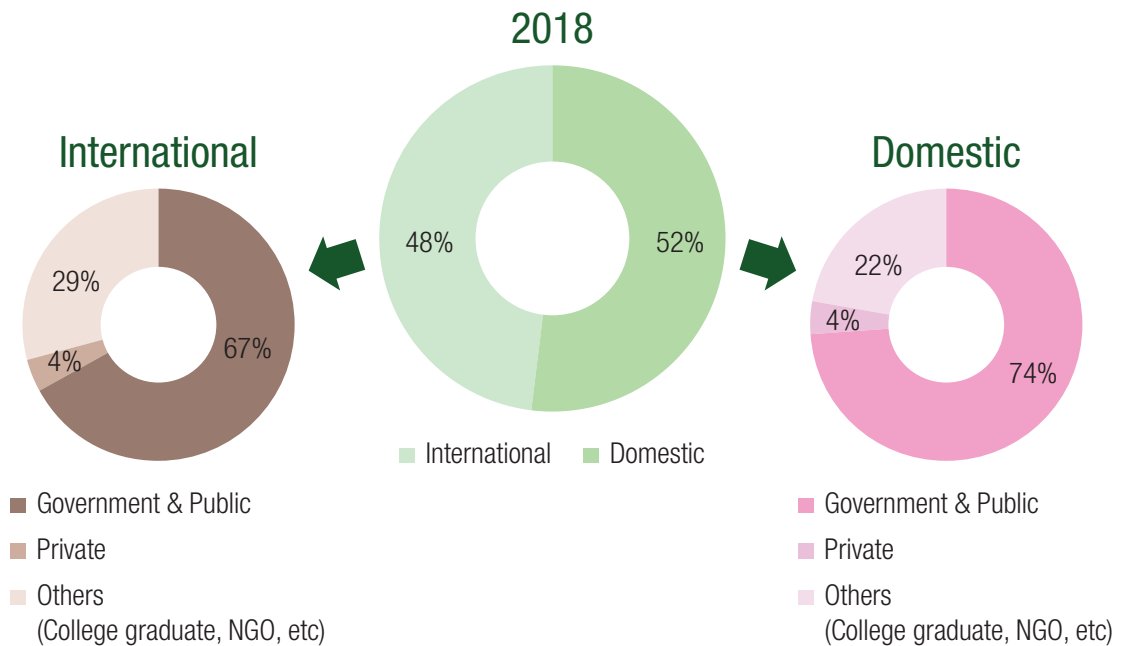
4. Globe-spanning Alumni Network (1998-2018)

What is NIIED GKS-KGSP?

The KGSP (Korean Government Scholarship Program) is a scholarship program sponsored by the NIIED (National Institute for International Education) and designed to provide higher education in Korea for international students in the aim of promoting international exchange in education and mutual friendship amongst the participating countries.

Qualifications	<p>① The applicant and his/her parents must hold foreign citizenships. * Applicants with the Korean citizenship are not permitted to apply for this program.</p> <p>② Applicants must be under 40 years of age of the selection year. * Those who were born after September 1st, 1979, are eligible to apply. * An applicant who are working as a professor at the time of applying must be under 45 years of age as of September 1, 2019(born after September 1, 1974)</p> <p>③ Applicants must hold a Bachelor's or Master's degree as of September 1st of the selection year. * Applicants who have completed an undergraduate program, a master's program, or a doctoral program in Korea are ineligible to apply for the program.</p> <p>④ The academic achievement of the applicants must meet one of the followings: - The grade point average (GPA) must be no less than 2.64 on a 4.0 scale, 2.80 on a 4.3 scale, 2.91 on a 4.5 scale; - The overall grades must be no less than 80% out of 100%</p>

- ※ *Each designated embassy has a different application process and applicants applying via embassy must check with the embassy first*
